
OUR MISSION & VISION

Our vision is to become a first-choice safe haven for Veterans and the underserved by providing a one-stop resource for life-saving services as they transition from homelessness/crisis to a healthy, productive and self-reliant lifestyle.

NVOP's primary path for accomplishing this vision is a three-step process thru which we house the Veteran, assess/address mental health needs, and reintegrate the Veteran into the workforce. This proven technique will reinforce the success achieved and strengthen the Veteran's resolve to sustain that success. NVOP aims to implement this strategy in all Texas NVOP sites and then export that strategy to States where there is great need for Veteran services.

As a veteran myself, I understand the challenges our service members overcome every day during their service. It is our mission to stand up for them with the same courage and fortitude they have shown in defending our nation.


OUR IMPACT
